PRIOR TO THE WORKSHOP DAY:

Space:

- 40' x 40' (approximately).
- Auditorium, all-purpose room or large classroom.
- Area selected for the workshop must be large enough to accommodate your whole group to be in a circle and move around.

Surface:

- Freshly mopped (not waxed)
- Irregularities covered with tape
- Extraneous clutter removed.

Assistance:

- One teacher per thirty-five students.

Equipment:

- Chalkboard or Whiteboard with chalk, markers and eraser
- DVD and Monitor (may be needed for certain sessions)
- Chairs for students and artist

Students should bring:

- nametags, pencil
- a notebook ("Play Book") to class for journaling, taking notes and other original writing (grades 2 & up)

ON WORKSHOP DAY:

Arrival:

- 15-30 minutes prior to the scheduled start time to prepare and set up.

Parking:

- One space near the venue for loading and unloading.

Assistance:

- Please have a school representative ready to welcome the artist and to stay and help as needed.

Start Time:

- Please prepare to start the program on time.
- Students should be in the workshop space, seated and ready to begin at the listed times.
